ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 7-12-170 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by striking out certain language and adding new language underlined as follows:

7-12-170 License fees.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

~~(e) A processing fee, not to exceed \$1.00, shall be charged on all credit card transactions conducted over the internet or other electronic transactions.~~


(c)(d) No fee shall be charged for:

(1) any service dog which is properly trained to guide or otherwise assist a blind person; or

(2) any dog which is the property of any subdivision of local, state or federal government.

(d)(e) Each dog license issued after July 1, 2008 shall expire at the end of the applicable one or three year period or on the expiration date of the certificate of inoculation that is in effect at the time the dog license is issued, whichever is earlier.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication.
