ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Section 4-233-060 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language, as follows:

**4-233-060 Geographical restrictions.**

No person requiring a license under this chapter shall engage in booting operations at any location that is outside the 1<sup>st</sup> Ward, 15<sup>th</sup> Ward, 21<sup>st</sup> Ward, 22<sup>nd</sup> Ward, 23<sup>rd</sup> Ward, 25<sup>th</sup> Ward, 26<sup>th</sup> Ward, 27<sup>th</sup> Ward, 30<sup>th</sup> Ward, 32<sup>nd</sup> Ward, 33<sup>rd</sup> Ward, 34<sup>th</sup> Ward, 37<sup>th</sup> Ward, 38<sup>th</sup> Ward, 40<sup>th</sup> Ward, 42<sup>nd</sup> Ward, 43<sup>rd</sup> Ward, 44<sup>th</sup> Ward, 46<sup>th</sup> Ward, 48<sup>th</sup> Ward, or 49<sup>th</sup> Ward.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.


