**RESOLUTION**

**BE IT RESOLVED,** (A) That all matters introduced into the City Council of the City of Chicago prior to May 4, 2011 on which no final action has been taken shall be considered as having "Failed to Pass"; except for: (1) applications for condominium refuse rebates, senior sewer rebates and small claims pending in the Committee on Finance, (2) those text amendments as to which notice of a committee hearing scheduled for May 26, 2011 has been published in the Chicago Sun-Times on May 10, 2011, pending in the former Committee on Zoning, and proposals for zoning map amendments pending in that same committee, (3) routine matters (for purposes of this resolution, municipal code amendments are not routine) pending in the former Committee on Traffic Control and Safety and (4) proposals for grants of privilege in the public way pending in the former Committee on Transportation and Public Way.


(B) With regard to matters pending in committee that are not disposed of pursuant to paragraph (A) of this resolution:

(1) The City Council Committee on Business Regulation and Consumer Protection shall have jurisdiction over matters pending in the former City Council Committee on License and Consumer Protection;


(2) The City Council Committee on Special Events, Cultural Affairs and Recreation shall have jurisdiction over matters pending in the former City Council Committee on Special Events and Cultural Affairs;

(3) The City Council Committee on Pedestrian and Traffic Safety shall have jurisdiction over matters pending in the former City Council Committee on Traffic Control and Safety; and

(4) The City Council Committee on Zoning, Landmarks and Building Standards shall have jurisdiction over matters pending in the former City Council Committees on Buildings and Historical Landmark Preservation.
