

- Loading zones are designated areas in the curb lane for the loading and unloading of deliveries by commercial vehicles only
- Any commercial vehicle can utilize any loading zone for up to 30 minutes.
- Any passenger vehicle parking in a loading zone during the restricted hours is in violation of the Chicago Municipal Code and is liable to receive a citation.
- It is illegal to post additional signage in the public way, including signage which would cause one to assert that the loading zone is reserved solely for your business.
