**WHEREAS,** General David C. Jones was a decorated military leader and the loving husband for sixty-seven years of the late Lois; and

**WHEREAS,** General David C. Jones was the much-adored father of Kathy, Susan and David to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** General David C. Jones served as the 9<sup>th</sup> Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff under Presidents Jimmy Carter and Ronald Reagan; and

**WHEREAS,** During his highly distinguished tenure as Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff from 1978 to 1982, General David C. Jones oversaw an extensive reorganization of the military's command; and

**WHEREAS,** Serving longer than any predecessor on the Joint Chiefs of Staff, General David C. Jones had been the Air Force Chief of Staff; and

**WHEREAS,** A native of Aberdeen, South Dakota, General David C. Jones served his country during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War; and


**WHEREAS,** The bravery, sacrifice and dedication of General David C. Jones serve as an example to all; and
