*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to CODA DI VOLPE upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 3335 N SOUTHPORT AVE.

Said Awning with Lettering or Graphics(s) at N. SOUTHPORT AVE measure(s):  
One (1) at twenty-eight (28) feet in length and Zero (0) feet in width for a total of twenty-eight (28) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1148441 herein granted the sum of fifty-three (\$53.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

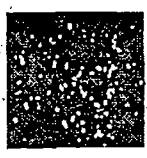
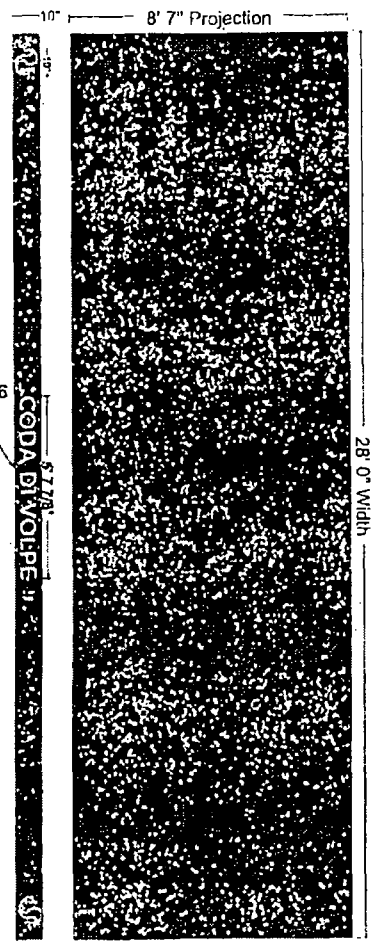

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 10/14/2020.



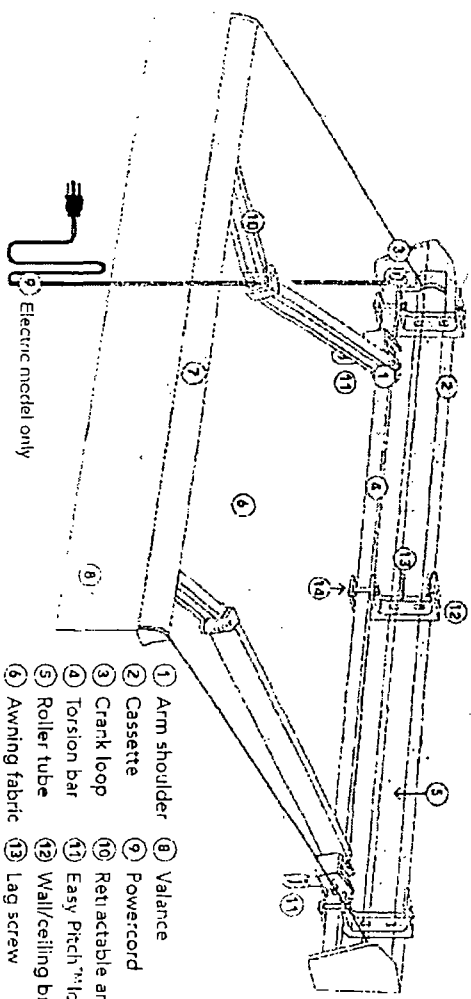

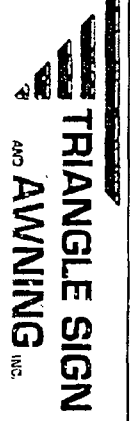
