RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa has gone to eternal life at the age of 87; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa served five terms as the Prime Minister of Nepal under three Kings; and

WHEREAS, Born in Muga, Dhankuta, Nepal, the Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa's political career spanned 50 years; and

WHEREAS, Following the formation of a multi-party Democracy in 1990, the Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa formed the Rastriya Prajatantra Party; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa stepped down from his final term as Prime Minister in 2005 and was the oldest member of the 601-member Constituent Assembly; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa was an iconic and widely respected leader of the Himalayan state who devoted his life to public service; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa is survived by three daughters and a son who is Nepal's commerce and supply minister; and


WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Surya Bahadur Thapa serve as an example to all; and
