WHEREAS, Ride for AIDS Chicago is a two-day, 200 plus mile bicycle ride from the campus of Northwestern University to south-central Wisconsin, and is produced by Test Positive Aware Network (TPAN) to raise funds for HIV/AIDS services in the Chicagoland area; and,

WHEREAS, Ride for AIDS Chicago was first conceived in 2002 when a group of committed volunteers wanted to create a challenging cycling event that promised to return 100% of pledged dollars to charity; and,

WHEREAS, Over the past several years, the size of the ride has grown steadily in both participation and fundraising; and,

WHEREAS, Ride for AIDS Chicago supports organizations and programs that serve all people in the Chicagoland area who are impacted by HIV, regardless of age, gender, race, or neighborhood; and,


