WHEREAS, A 2008 graduate of Moline High School, Adam E. Dobereiner was active on the football and wrestling teams and will be remembered by his classmates, teachers and coaches as a hardworking and selfless young man; and

WHEREAS, Adam E. Dobereiner inspired the lives of countless people through his great personal goodness, charity and concern; and


WHEREAS, The heroism, dedication and sacrifice of Adam E. Dobereiner serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, His love of life and ability to live it to the fullest endeared Adam E. Dobereiner to his family members, friends and all who knew him, and enabled him to enrich their lives in ways they will never forget; and

WHEREAS, To his beloved family, Adam E. Dobereiner imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this fourteenth day of December, 2011, do hereby commemorate Adam E. Dobereiner for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
