RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On Wednesday, January 26, 2022, the City Council passed a resolution honoring International Holocaust Remembrance Day, which is celebrated January 27, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Despite this, and signifying the importance of never forgetting the Holocaust, in the last weekend of January, multiple anti-Semitic incidents struck the Fiftieth Ward; and

WHEREAS, On Saturday, January 29, 2022, a synagogue and two Jewish-owned businesses, Kol Tuv Kosher Foods and Tel-Aviv Kosher Bakery, had their windows broken; and

WHEREAS, On Sunday, January 30, 2022, a man spray-painted a synagogue and a cargo container on the grounds of a Jewish high school with yellow swastikas in West Rogers Park, and shattered windows at another synagogue; and

WHEREAS, Later on that same Sunday, mere hours after the incidents were discovered, Chicago Police Department officers arrested the alleged offender; and

WHEREAS, On Monday, February 1, 2022, the alleged offender was charged with four counts of hate crimes as well as charges of criminal damage and defacement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and Members of the City Council of the City of Chicago, assembled this twenty-third day of March 2022, do hereby honor and salute the following members of the Chicago Police Department for their diligent and timely efforts in apprehending the alleged offender: Captain William Clucas Star # 111; Commander Joseph E. Brennan Star # 25; CAPS Sergeant Shawn Sisk Star #1825; Police Officer Roger Heath Jr. Star #15011 – 24th District Place of Worship Safety Advisory Team; Police Officer Michael Specht Star #7681 – 24th District Place of Worship Safety Advisory Team; 3rd Watch Sergeant Christopher Stachula Star #1668; 2406 Mission Team of Sergeant Syed Quadri Star #2406, Police Officer Enes Mencovic Star #2817, Police Officer Slawomir Skubaja Star #9475, Police Officer Artur Tomkow Star #18747, Police Officer Maureen Boyle Star #5525, Police Officer Zohaib Zaib Star #10988, and Police Officer Samer Ihmoud Star #17044; Area 3 Detectives Jonathan Reeder Star #21317, Saud Haidari Star # 21822, and Detective Colin O'Shea Star # 21105; and Area 5 Detective Mohammed Hamideh Star # 21153.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be presented to these members of the Chicago Police Department, and placed on permanent record in their personnel files, as a token of our appreciation and esteem.
