## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God; and

**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss was a former United States Ambassador to the Soviet Union and the loving husband of the late Helen; and

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss was the much-adored father of three children to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss was a former presidential advisor to Jimmy Carter, Ronald Regan and George H.W. Bush and was renowned for bringing together opposing sides and solidifying agreements; and

**WHEREAS,** In addition to his ambassadorship, Robert S. Strauss was Special Envoy to the Middle East and United States Trade Representative; and

**WHEREAS,** Widely regarded for his political influence and skill as an attorney, Robert S. Strauss was the co-founder of an international law firm; and

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss served as the Chairman of the Democratic National Committee from 1972 to 1977; and

**WHEREAS,** In recognition of his many contributions to his country, Robert S. Strauss was the 1981 recipient of the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the nation's highest award presented to a civilian; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Robert S. Strauss serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** Robert S. Strauss will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, Robert S. Strauss imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this second day of April, 2014, do hereby commemorate Robert S. Strauss for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
