WHEREAS, Prior to her appointment, Dr. Jo Ann Rooney served as the Managing Director of the Huron Consulting Group in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, In 2010 Dr. Jo Ann Rooney briefly served as President of Mount Ida College in Newton, Massachusetts before being called by the Obama Administration to serve in the United States Department of Defense as Principal Deputy Secretary of Defense for Personnel and Readiness; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Jo Ann Rooney is a recipient of the Department of Defense Medal for Distinguished Public Service, the highest honor given to a civilian by the Secretary of Defense; and

WHEREAS, In 2003 Dr. Jo Ann Rooney was inaugurated as the President of Spaulding University in Louisville, Kentucky where she served for eight years; and

WHEREAS, In addition to her work as an administrator, Dr. Jo Ann Rooney worked for more than a dozen years teaching graduate and undergraduate courses; and

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Dr. Jo Ann Rooney serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Jo Ann Rooney will be installed as President during a ceremony held on the Lake Shore Campus, 1032 West Sheridan Road, Chicago, Illinois; now, therefore
