WHEREAS, The Honorable Donna Lee Phelps Felton was a faithful member of Concord Missionary Baptist Church in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Donna Lee Phelps Felton serve as an example to all; and

WHEREAS, To her beloved family, the Honorable Donna Lee Phelps Felton imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
