**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** Arthur Thompson, Sr., was a retired Chicago Police Department Commander and the loving husband for sixty-six years of Bessie; and

**WHEREAS,** Arthur Thompson, Sr., was the much-adored father of Damon, Kaye, Michael, Arthur II, Anthony and Marc, the grandfather of eleven and the great-grandfather of four to whom he imparted many of the fine and noble qualities that he possessed in abundance; and

**WHEREAS,** Arthur Thompson, Sr., served as a Company Clerk in the infantry during World War II; and
