KANELA CAFE

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to KANELA CAFE, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 3231 N. Clark St..

Said Awning(s) at N. Clark measure(s):

One (1) at nineteen point six (19.6) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of ninety-eight (98) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1095699 herein granted the sum of fifty (\$50.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.




Traditional style stationary awning with end wings and a stationary valance manufactured complete and installed over the west face entrance. Awning made of 1" sq. and 2" rd. welded galvanized steel silver tubing with welds ground, primed and painted silver. Awning mounted to wall with 3/8" x 3" lag bolts and 3/8" x 2" lag shields. Fabric attached by the lace-on method, using Sunbrella material #4621, true brown.

- Lettering/loop to be white color applied to both roof and valance area AS SHOWN BELOW.
