1. The first step in the synthesis of the target molecule is the reaction of the starting material with the reagent.

2. The second step involves the purification of the intermediate product by distillation.

3. The third step is the reaction of the purified intermediate with the second reagent to form the final product.

4. The final product is then purified by recrystallization to obtain the pure compound.

5. The yield of the final product is approximately 65% based on the starting material.

6. The overall reaction scheme is shown below.

7. The reaction conditions are as follows: 1) 0°C, 2) room temperature, 3) 50°C.

8. The starting material is a colorless liquid with a boiling point of 78°C.

9. The intermediate product is a white solid with a melting point of 100°C.

10. The final product is a colorless solid with a melting point of 150°C.

11. The molecular weight of the final product is 150 g/mol.

12. The reaction is exothermic.
