*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Verizon Wireless, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use Occupation of Space (Cell Antenna System) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2000 N. Parkside Ave..

Said Occupation of Space (Cell Antenna System) at N. Parkside measure(s):

One (1) at two point two five (2.25) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of four point five (4.5) square feet. Cell antenna system shall be approximately thirty-two (32) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1120924 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

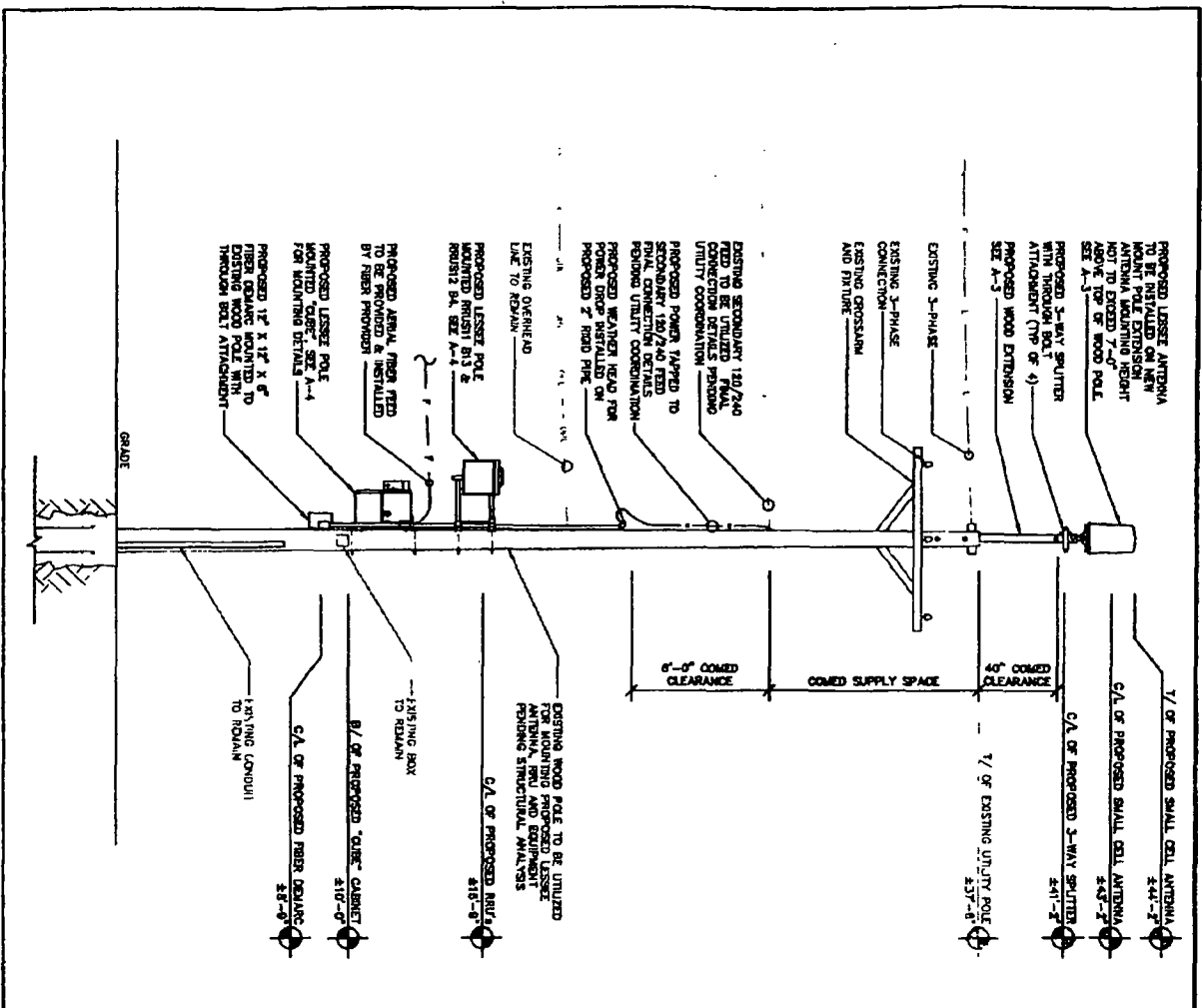
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

 1. THE SCOPE OF WORK DOES NOT INCLUDE A STRUCTURAL EVALUATION OF THIS TOWER OR THE TOWER OR STRUCTURE HAS THE CAPACITY TO ADEQUATELY SUPPORT THESE ANTENNAS. PRIOR TO ANY ANTENNA INSTALLATION, A STRUCTURAL EVALUATION OF THE TOWER OR STRUCTURE SHOULD BE PERFORMED.

 1. ANY AND ALL DAMAGE TO POLE DUE TO THE CONSTRUCTION & INSTALLATION SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR AT THE COST OF THE CONTRACTOR.

1. LICENSEE'S ATTACHMENT TO COATED SOLIDLY OWNED POLES SHALL BE FLUSH, MOUNTED AND AFFIXED WITH A THROUGH BOLT TYPE ATTACHMENT DEVICE. THE THROUGH BOLT MAY NOT PROTRUDE MORE THAN 2" FROM THE POLE SURFACE AS TO AVOID PAINT TO THOSE WORKERS THAT CLIMB THE POLE TO MAINTAIN THE TOWER. LICENSEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE USE OF ANY TYPE OF BRACKET PROVIDED BY THE LICENSEE TO SUPPORT ITS WIRELESS ATTACHMENTS. WHEN BRACING IS REQUIRED ON JOINTLY OWNED POLES, LICENSEE SHALL COORDINATE AND PROVIDE SIGN WITH JOINT OWNER IF LICENSEE DESIRES TO HAVE SIGNAGE AND LICENSEE SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DESIGN OF SUCH SIGNAGE. ANTENNA AND POWER SUPPLY SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED ONTO POLES WITH STATIC POLE ATTACHMENTS ONTO EXISTING FIBERGLASS POLE TOP TERMINATIONS, OR ONTO POLES WHERE THEY PRESENT AN UNSAFE CLIMBING HAZARD.
  2. LICENSEE'S WIRELESS ATTACHMENTS SHALL NOT "BOX" THE POLE AS THE COATED FACILITY TO PROTECT IT FROM CORROSION. THE LICENSEE SHALL ALWAYS MAINTAIN THE COATING OF THE POLES. THE LICENSEE SHALL MAINTAIN ALL WIRING FACILITIES. LICENSEE SHALL NOT PLACE UNDERCUT, CONDUIT, ETC. ON THE BASE OF THE POLE AND SHALL BE ALLOWED TO PLACE A MARKING OF ONE FOOT OF THE POLE TO BE COVERED AND SECURED WITH A FIBERGLASS PROTECTIVE SHEATH (TOWER DESIGN BY OTHERS UNDER SEPARATE PERMIT).
