## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of 90; and

**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers was a former Arkansas Governor and United States Senator who enjoyed a long and highly distinguished career in public service; and

**WHEREAS,** The son of a state legislator, the Honorable Dale Bumpers was born in Charleston, Arkansas, and worked as a small town attorney; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers earned the nickname "giant killer" because of his success in defeating a series of well-established politicians during primary and general election battles; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers served from 1971 to 1975 as the 38<sup>th</sup> Governor of Arkansas and was elected to the United States Senate four times between 1975 and 1999; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers was known throughout his tenure in the Senate for his respect for the U.S. Constitution and opposition to constitutional amendments; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers served from 1987 to 1995 as Chairman of the Senate Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Dale Bumpers serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** The Honorable Dale Bumpers was an individual of great integrity and accomplishment who will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS,** To his loving wife, Betty, and his three children, Brent, Bill and Brooke, the Honorable Dale Bumpers imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore **BE IT RESOLVED,** That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this thirteenth day of January, 2016, do hereby commemorate the Honorable Dale Bumpers for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
