LOU MALNATI'S PIZZERIA

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to LOU MALNATI'S PIZZERIA, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Canopy(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 6465 S. Cicero Ave..

Said Canopy(s) at S. Cicero Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at fifty-four point three three (54.33) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of two hundred seventy-one point six five (271.65) square feet.

Said Canopy(s) at W. 65th Street measure(s):

One (1) at forty point five eight (40.58) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of two hundred two point nine (202.9) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.


The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124642 herein granted the sum of one hundred forty-four dollars and ninety-one cents (\$144.91) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

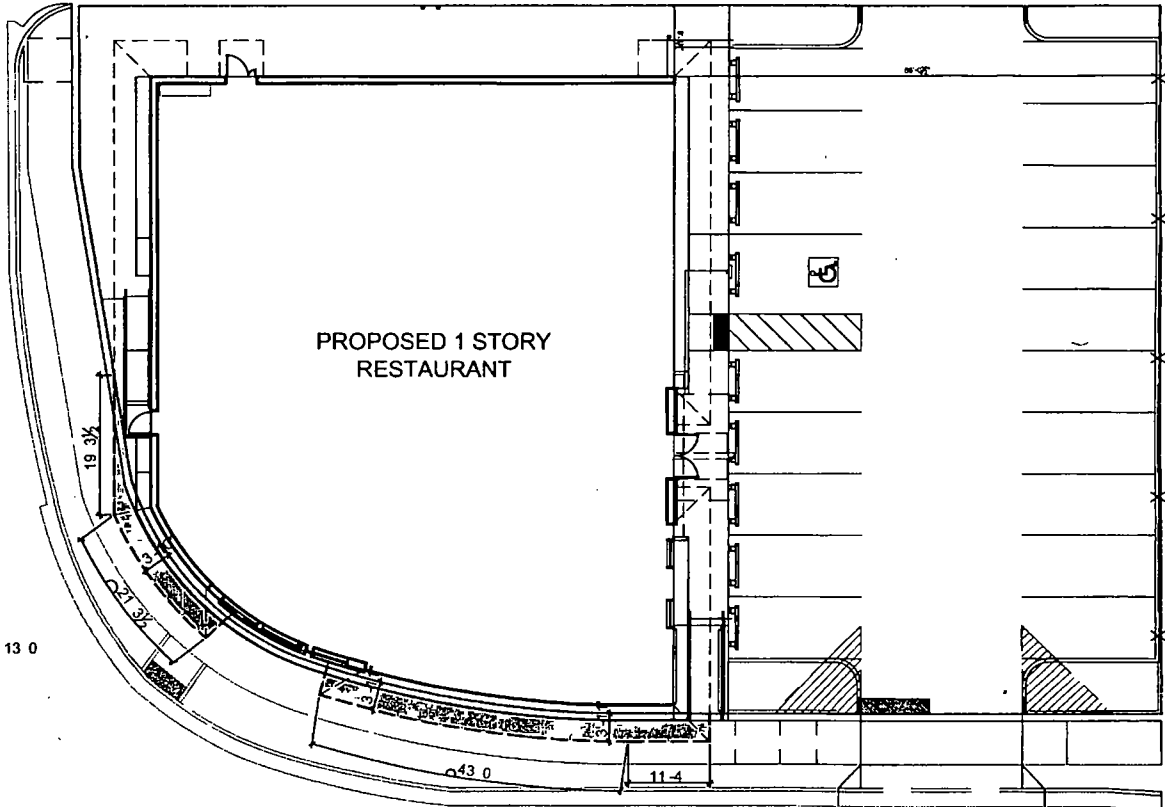
