ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the current RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 2-G in the area bounded by:

a line 199.0 feet north of and parallel to West Taylor Street; the public alley east of and parallel to South Miller Street; a line 139.0 feet north of and parallel to West Taylor Street; and South Miller Street

to those of a RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.



In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about September 14, 2021, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from a RT-4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District to a RM-5 Residential Multi-Unit District on behalf of 911 S Miller, LLC (the "Applicant") for the property located at 911-13 South Miller Street, Chicago, Illinois 60607. The property is bounded by:
