**ORDINANCE**


**WHEREAS**, the City of Chicago is a home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; now, therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Section 9-64-090(f) of the Code, the following address ranges are designated as buffer zones for a residential parking permit zone (Zone 394). The residents living in the following address ranges, on both sides of the indicated streets, are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 394), as a result of insufficient available parking caused by that adjacent zone:

1250 to 1338 S. Indiana Avenue  
1142 to 1347 S. Michigan Avenue  
1300 to 1353 S. Wabash Avenue  
63 E. 14<sup>th</sup> Street  
125 to 233 E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street  
1336 to 1522 S. Prairie Avenue

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance will be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
