RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of eighty-three; and

WHEREAS, The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

WHEREAS, A native of New Jersey, Brother Philip Kennedy was a member of the Catholic order of the Alexian Brothers for more than sixty-five years; and

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy joined the Congregation of Alexian Brothers in 1946, an order which ministers to people through healthcare centers around the globe; and

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy earned a master's in hospital administration from Yale University; and

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy headed Alexian Brothers Medical Center in Elk Grove Village from 1983 to 1997 and during his tenure transformed what was then a small community hospital into a major modern medical facility; and

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy elevated the level of care by developing the Alexian Brothers Regional Cancer Care Center and by instituting a partnership between the hospital and the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Brother Philip Kennedy was committed to providing quality healthcare to all patients regardless of their ability to pay; and

WHEREAS, In 2001 the Catholic Healthcare Association of the United States honored Brother Philip Kennedy for his leadership and inspiration within the healthcare industry; and

WHEREAS, To his two brothers, Donald and Richard, and his sister, Jane, Brother Philip Kennedy imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this sixth day of June, 2012, do hereby commemorate Brother Philip Kennedy for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be presented to the family of Brother Philip Kennedy.
