**ORDINANCE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council finds that the area described in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

**SECTION 2.** Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (30.52) as follows:

4-60-022        Restrictions on additional licenses.  
Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises with the following areas:

(30.52)        On the east side of North Pulaski Road, from West Wellington Avenue to North Milwaukee Avenue.

**SECTION 3.** Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-023 (30.61) as follows:

4-60-023        Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.  
Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021(c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

(30.61)        On the east side of North Pulaski Road, from West Wellington Avenue to North Milwaukee Avenue.

*(omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
