
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CHICAGO

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 9-64-090 (f) of the Code, the following address ranges are designated as buffer zones for residential parking zone 100. The residents living in the following address ranges of the indicated streets are eligible to acquire a permit to park in the adjacent residential parking permit zone (Zone 100):

2500-2542 N. Kedzie, west side of the street only

3209-3221 W. Altgeld, both sides of the street

SECTION 2. This ordinance will be in full force and effect on December 1, 2015.
