UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, Slurry Walls Tie Back Anchor Lines under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5807 S. Woodlawn Ave..

Said Slurry Wall(s) at E. 58th Street measure(s):

One (1) at fourteen thousand eight hundred twenty (14820) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of fourteen thousand eight hundred twenty (14820) square feet.

Said Slurry Wall(s) at S. Woodlawn Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at nine thousand three hundred nine (9309) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of nine thousand three hundred nine (9309) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1102748 herein granted the sum of eight hundred eighty (\$880.00) per annum in advance.

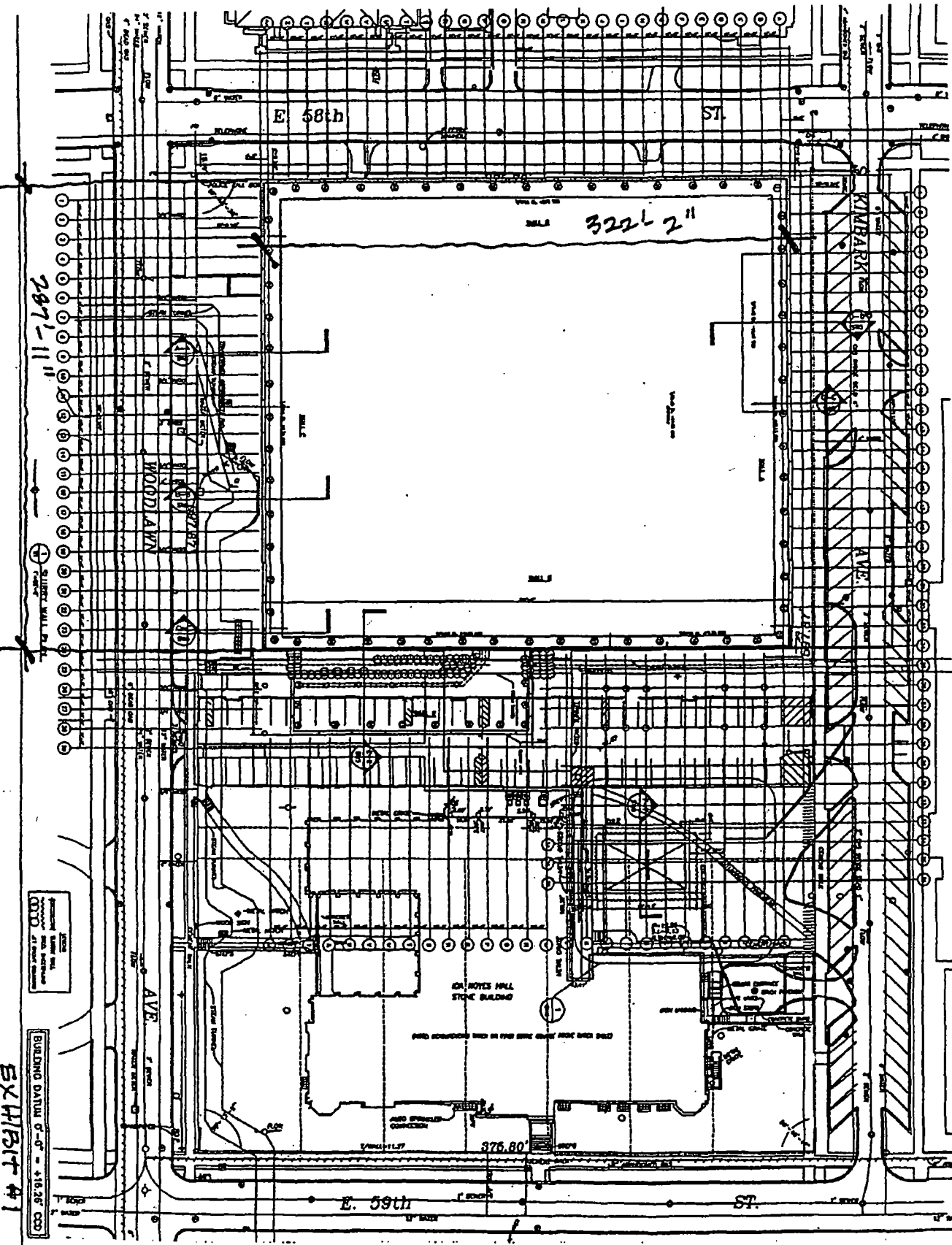
A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
