REGAL LOFTS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to REGAL LOFTS CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, six (6) Guardrail(s) over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1735 W. Diversey Pkwy..

Said Guardrail(s) at W. Diversey Pkwy measure(s):

Two (2) at eleven point five (11.5) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of eleven point five (11.5) square feet. Existing guardrails are approximately four (4) feet above grade level.

Two (2) at eleven point five (11.5) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of eleven point five (11.5) square feet. Existing guardrails are approximately five (5) feet above grade level.

Two (2) at eleven point five (11.5) feet in length, and point five (.5) feet in width for a total of eleven point five (11.5) square feet. Existing guardrails are approximately three (3) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1116261 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

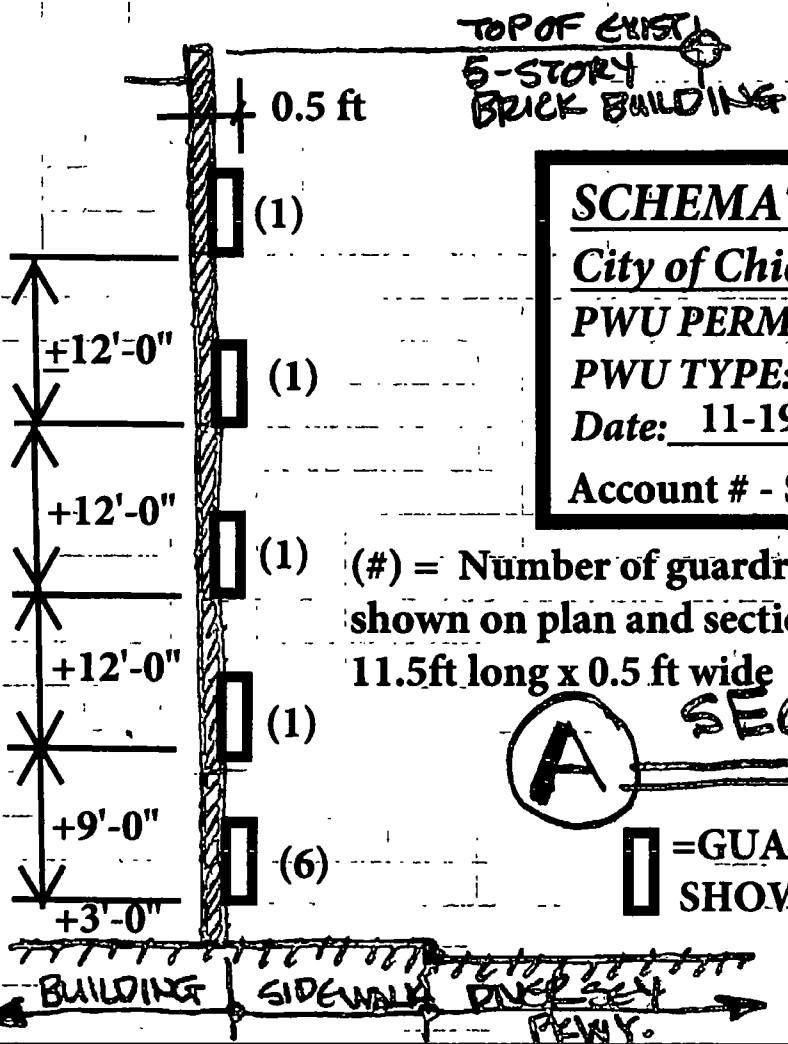
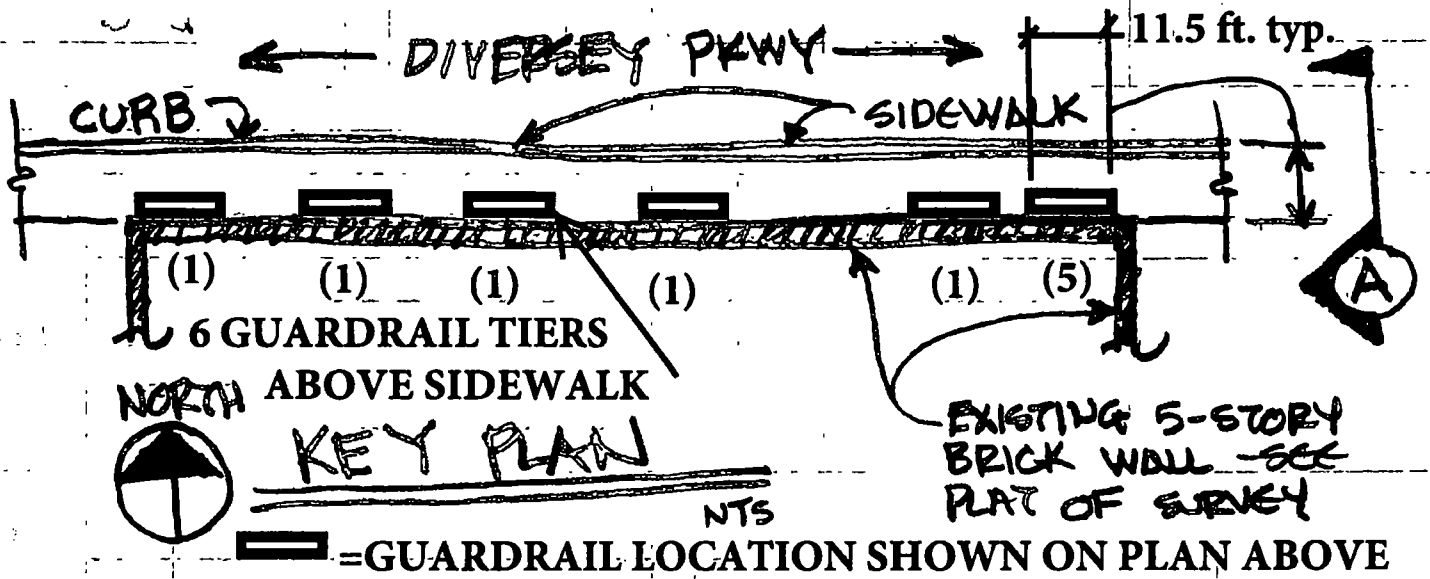
