I am writing in reference to Resolution Number #2019-348. My vote was not recorded the way that I had intended. I approached the Clerk during the July 24th 2019 City Council Meeting to correct this. Yet due to a parliamentary error on my part it was not changed. I would like the official record to include this letter documenting that it was my intention to be a 'yes' vote.

The recent developments in states like Georgia, Alabama, Missouri and Ohio are led by extremists who seek to subvert the legislative process and allow activist judges to reinterpret long-standing precedent. I join my other 46 colleagues in a full-throated condemnation of these fringe policies that seek to undermine democracy and women's reproductive health.

Thank you for making this letter an official part of the record, that I had intended my vote on this issue to reflect my desire to support the resolution and to have voted "yes."
