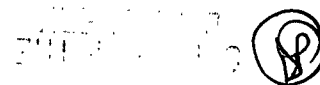
**WHEREAS,** CICS Wrightwood Campus is a kindergarten thru eighth grade school with approximately seven hundred students; now, therefore,
