**WHEREAS**, Diane Taylor-Evans has chosen to retire on January 31, 2012 after 37 years of faithful and dedicated service to the general populace of the Chicago Public Library; and


**WHEREAS**, the Chicago City Council has been informed of this by 18<sup>th</sup> Ward Alderman Lona Lane; and

**WHEREAS**, Diane began her career at the Chicago Public Library in 1974 as a Clerk II in the Cataloging Department for two years until she took a leave of absence in 1977. She returned to the Chicago Public Library in 1978 as a Clerk II in the Music Department in the Central Library (Cultural Center). In 1978 the Music Department was merged with the Art Department and became the Visual and Performing Arts Division, where Diane served as Clerk II until 1988. In 1988 she was promoted to a Clerk III in the Thomas Hughes Children's Library, and she then was promoted to the Head Clerk in the Thomas Hughes Library in 1991, when the Central Library moved into the Harold Washington Library Center. In 1997 she was transferred to the Scottsdale Branch, and in 1998 she was transferred to the New Wrightwood-Ashburn Branch until her retirement; and

**WHEREAS**, Diane will retire after 37 years of service to spend more time with her family and friends; and now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED**, That we, the Mayor and members of the City Council of the City of Chicago, gathered here in assembly this eighteenth day of January, 2012, A.D., do hereby express our congratulations and best wishes to Diane Taylor-Evans on the occasion of her retirement; and
