Section 1:

The ordinance passed by the City Council of the City of Chicago for **RESTORATION HARDWARE** on **09/24/2015**, and printed upon page **7209** of the Journal of Proceedings of the City of Chicago is here by Amended by deleting the words

“eight (8) Light Fixture(s) projecting over the public right-of-way

Eight (8) at point three three (.33) feet in length, point six six (.66) feet in width and nine hundred ninety-nine thousand nine hundred ninety-nine (0) feet above grade level.”

and inserting in their place the words

“eight (8) Light fixture(s) in the public right-of-way

Eight (8) at four (4) inches in length and four (4) inches in width.

Said light fixtures shall be located in the sidewalk to illuminate existing historical building.”
