ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the current C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District and a M1-1, Limited Manufacturing/Business Park District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 5-K in the area bounded by:

The public alley next north of and parallel to West Armitage Avenue; a line 389.0 feet east of and parallel to North Kilpatrick Avenue; West Armitage Avenue; and a line 314.0 feet east of and parallel to North Kilpatrick Avenue

to those of a C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

Narrative: The subject property is primarily a vacant lot that is improved with a garage at the rear of the property. The Applicant proposes to rezone the property from a C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District and a M1-1, Limited Manufacturing/Business Park District to a C1-1, Neighborhood Commercial District to build a 1 1/2 story, 3,514.516 square foot commercial building with office use that will include eight surface parking spaces. 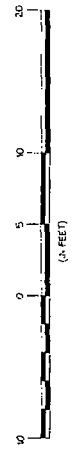

Remedies at law for a false statement of material fact may include incarceration and an award to the City of treble damages.

D. It is the City's policy to make this document available to the public on its Internet site and/or upon request. Some or all of the information provided in, and appended to, this EDS may be made publicly available on the Internet, in response to a Freedom of Information Act request, or otherwise. By completing and signing this EDS, the Disclosing Party waives and releases any possible rights or claims which it may have against the City in connection with the public release of information contained in this EDS and also authorizes the City to verify the accuracy of any information submitted in this EDS.
