WHEREAS, Mike Volini attended Quigley North High School, graduating in 1976. Mike then received a Bachelor's degree in Communications from Loyola University; and

WHEREAS, Mike Volini served his community as the 48th Ward Democratic Committeeman for fifteen years; and

WHEREAS, On October 16, 1989, Mr. Volini began his career with the City of Chicago as a Coordinator of Economic Development in the Department of Public Works, later named the Department of Transportation. On April 16, 1990, he became the Director of Programming for the Department of Public Works with responsibilities which included engaging in community outreach and monitoring relevant City and State legislation; and


