WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Henry "Heinz" Baerman serve as an example to all; and

*WHEREAS,* Henry "Heinz" Baerman will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS**, To his beloved family, Henry "Heinz" Baerman imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore
