WHEREAS, The Honorable Patricia J. Boyle graduated at the top of her class from Wayne State University Law School in the 1960s and was a pioneering female attorney who fought discrimination; and

WHEREAS, The Honorable Patricia J. Boyle served for fifteen years as a Michigan Supreme Court Justice and officially retired from the bench in 1998; and


WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Honorable Patricia J. Boyle serve as an example to all; and
