## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh has been called to eternal life by the wisdom of God at the age of 97; and

**WHEREAS,** The Chicago City Council has been informed of his passing by Alderman Edward M. Burke; and

**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh served as the President of Notre Dame University in South Bend, Indiana from 1952 to 1987; and

**WHEREAS,** During his highly distinguished tenure, the Reverend Theodore Hesburgh built Notre Dame into an academic powerhouse, opened its doors to women and greatly increased both its enrollment and endowment; and

**WHEREAS**, The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh authored the best-seller book, "God, County, Notre Dame" which laid out his vision for contemporary Catholic education; and

**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh was a champion of human rights and a founding member of the U.S. Civil Rights Commission; and

**WHEREAS,** The University of Notre Dame renamed its library in honor of the Reverend Theodore Hesburgh in 1987; and

**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh was a recipient of numerous honors and awards, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom; and

**WHEREAS,** The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of the Reverend Theodore Hesburgh serve as an example to all; and

**WHEREAS,** The Reverend Theodore Hesburgh will be dearly missed and fondly remembered by his many relatives, friends and admirers; and

**WHEREAS,** To his beloved family, the Reverend Theodore Hesburgh imparts a legacy of faithfulness, service and dignity; now, therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That we, the Mayor and the members of the Chicago City Council, assembled this eighteenth day of March, 2015, do hereby commemorate the Reverend Theodore Hesburgh for his grace-filled life and do hereby express our condolences to his family; and
