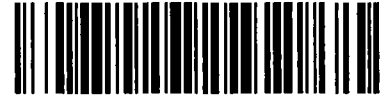

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UPTOWN UNITED, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Planter(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 4001 N. Sheridan Rd..

Said Planter(s) at N. SHERIDAN measure(s):

One (1) at four (4) feet in length, and four (4) feet in width for a total of sixteen (16) square feet.

Grantee must allow the required clear and unobstructed space for pedestrian passage at all times per rules and regulations approved by the Department of Transportation.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1106701 herein granted the sum of zero (\$0.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

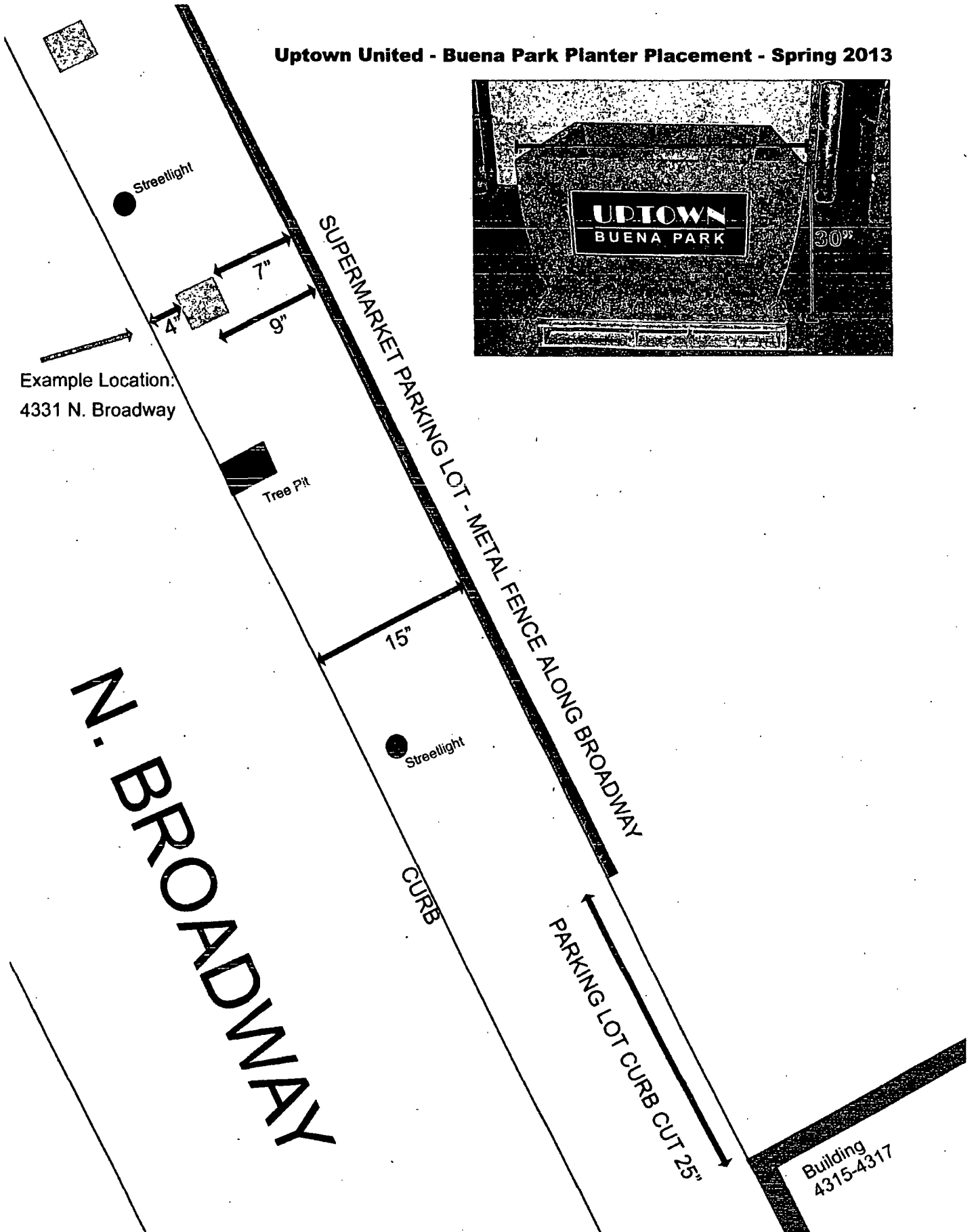
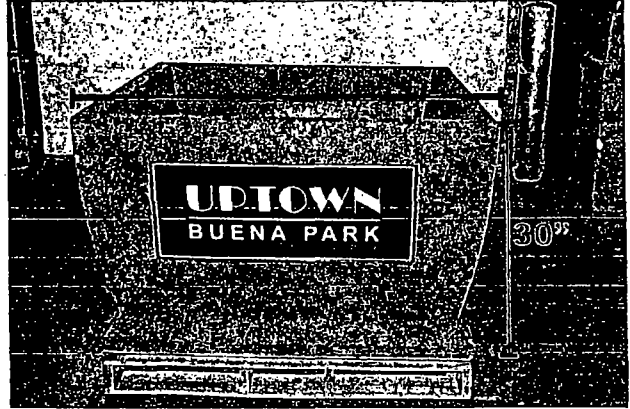
The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

### Uptown United - Buena Park Planter Placement - Spring 2013

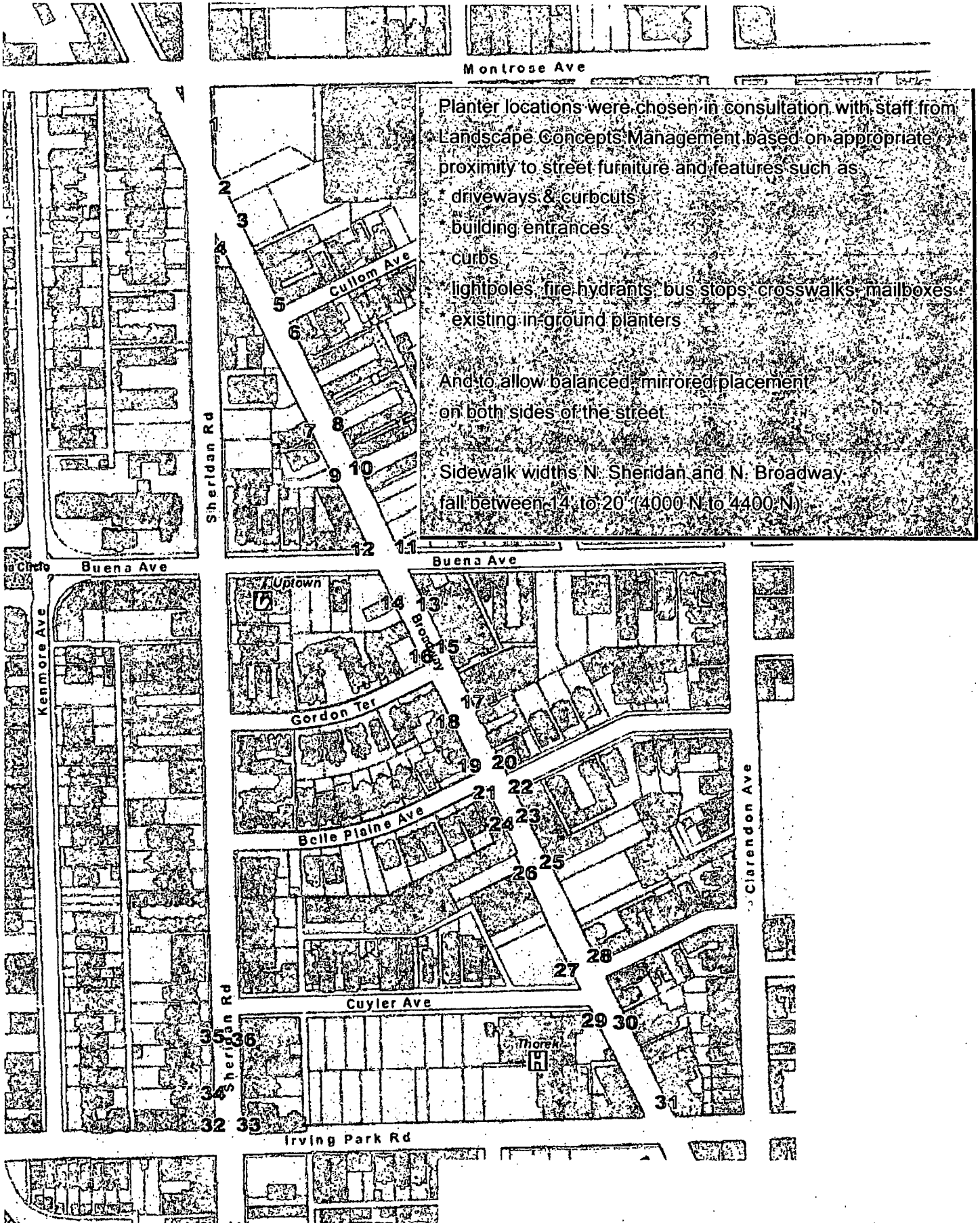

### Uptown United - Map of Buena Park Planter Placement - Spring 2013



Planter locations were chosen in consultation with staff from Landscape Concepts Management based on appropriate proximity to street furniture and features such as

- driveways & curbcuts
- building entrances
- curbs
- lightpoles, fire hydrants, bus stops, crosswalks, mailboxes
- existing in-ground planters

And to allow balanced, mirrored placement on both sides of the street.

Sidewalk widths N. Sheridan and N. Broadway fall between 14' to 20' (4000 N to 4400 N)
