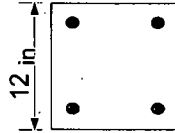

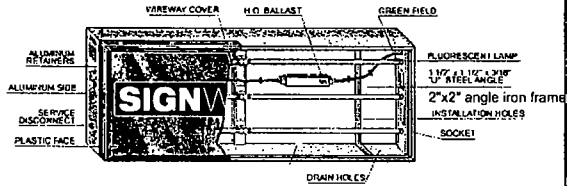
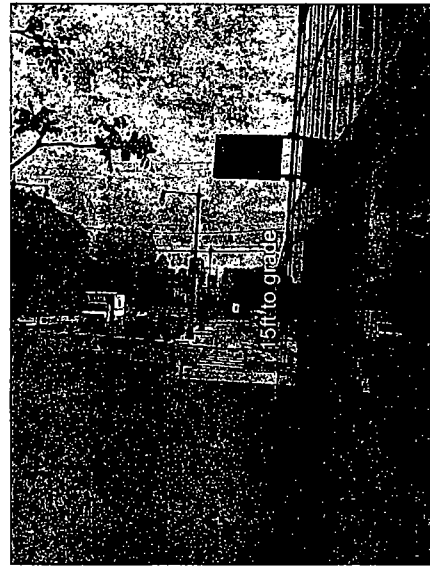

1/4" mounting plate

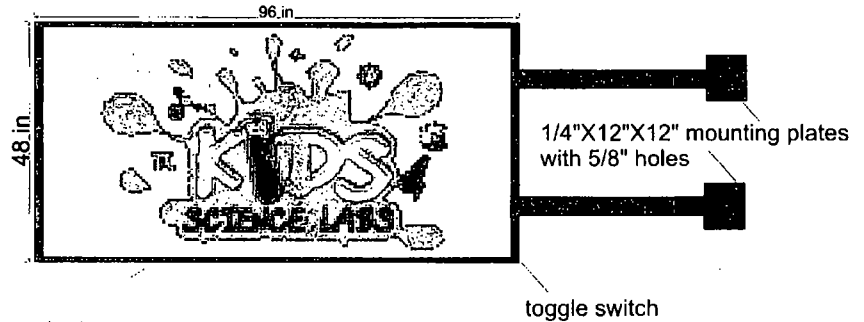


1/2" expansion bolts for installation
