**WHEREAS,** As the head of Chicago's oldest and largest homeless shelter, David D. McCarrell oversaw its move in 2007 from an outdated structure to a new \$27 million facility located at 1458 South Canal Street; and


**WHEREAS,** The hard work, compassion and dedication of David D. McCarrell serve as an example to all; and
