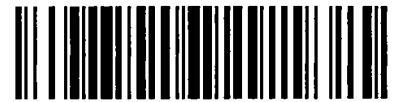

WHEREAS, The hard work, sacrifice and dedication of Chester Hornowski serve as an example to all; and


