### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the M1-2 Limited Manufacturing/Business Park District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 12-E in the area bounded by

A line 148.0 feet north of the north line of East 54th Street; the public alley next east of and parallel to South State Street; East 54th Street; and South State Street to those of a B3-2 Community Shopping District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.




A. The applicant proposes to rezone the subject property from M1-2 Limited Manufacturing/Business Park District to B3-2 Community Shopping District. The subject property is currently vacant. The purpose of the zoning amendment is to permit the applicant to construct a new approximately 30,000 square foot facility for a dance studio and performance space. There will be 5 parking spaces at the property. The building will be 2 stories and not exceed 45 feet in height. The subject property is a Transit Serviced Location based on proximity to the Garfield Boulevard and the number 55 Bus Line. The applicant is seeking the following relief: (i) parking relief for a Transit-Served Locations in accordance with 17-10-0102-B.






