# Proposed Ordinance to the Chicago City Council

“BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CHICAGO AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to Article VII, Section 6(f) and Section 11(a) of the 1970 Illinois Constitution, the Chicago City Council by resolution submits to the electors of the City of Chicago the following question of public policy at the next regular election occurring not less than 78 days after the passage of this referendum resolution:

**Shall Chicago adopt the following term limit for the office of Mayor effective for the mayoral election in 2023 and thereafter: No person may hold the office of Mayor for more than two consecutive elected 4-year terms?”**
