COMMERCIAL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 (a) of the 1970 constitution of the State of Illinois and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the properties at 401-409 N. Sangamon Street and 413-421 N. Sangamon Street are owned by WTF Reserve, LLC, an Illinois Limited Liability Company (WTF Reserve, LLC); and

WHEREAS, WTF Reserve, LLC proposes to use the portion of the alley to be vacated herein for access to their parking lot; and


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of public alley, described in the following ordinance; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1.

THAT PART OF AN EAST-WEST 12 FOOT WIDE PUBLIC ALLEY; LYING NORTH OF AND ADJOINING LOTS 10 AND 11, ALSO SOUTH OF AND ADJOINING THAT PART OF LOT 12, ALL INCLUSIVE, IN BLOCK 3 OF OGDEN'S ADDITION TO CHICAGO, RECORDED DECEMBER 9, 1879 AS DOCUMENT NO. 248024, LYING WEST OF AND ADJOINING THE NORTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE EAST LINE OF SAID LOT 10, AND LYING EAST OF AND ADJOINING THE EAST LINE OF N. SANGAMON STREET, ALL IN THE NORTHEAST ¼ OF SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, SAID PARCEL CONTAINING 1,031.99 SQ.FT. = 0.023 ACRES, as shaded and legally described by the words "HEREBY VACATED" on the plat hereto attached as Exhibit A, which drawing for greater clarity, is hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed, inasmuch as the same is no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation.

SECTION 2. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 180 days after the passage of this ordinance, WTF Reserve, LLC shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owner of the property abutting said part of public alley hereby vacated the sum dollars (\$),



SECTION 3. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within one hundred eighty (180) days after the passage of this ordinance, WTF Reserve, LLC shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached plat as approved by the Superintendent of Maps and Plats.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The vacation shall take effect and be in force from and after its recording.
