## CONGRATULATING WAYNE BUBAK ON BEING NAMED HUMANITARIAN OF THE YEAR BY THE ITALIAN AMERICAN POLICE ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, Faith, family, country and charity are the things that Wayne Bubak holds most dear; and

WHEREAS, Wayne's desire to help people comes from the values instilled in him by his parents and his Catholic school education. Since his childhood as an altar boy, he has continued assisting the church as an altar server, lector and head usher for 34 years. He also has headed the Parish and Finance Councils. Over the years, Wayne has organized and assisted in numerous events for his parish and related charities. He is also a member of the Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus, St. Michael the Archangel Council, the only Knights of Columbus Council of law enforcement officers in the United States; and

WHEREAS, Wayne is married to his high school sweetheart, Mary Frances, a retired CPS school teacher/administrator. Together, they are parents of three successful adult children and four grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, Elected to the Northbrook Elementary School Board District 27 and later to the Northfield Township High School District 225, Wayne rose to the level of president. He also served as an executive member of the North Suburban Special Education District; and

WHEREAS, Professionally, Wayne has spent a lifetime in service to his country. He started out as purchasing agent for the Defense Department and then became a U.S. Treasury agent. He worked mainly with the Federal Grand Jury in the Northern District of Illinois, focusing primarily on political corruption cases. He had the first two prosecutions involving "extortion under official color of right," using political office for monetary gain. He also served in Dignitary Protection, guarding presidents and other dignitaries, and taught at the Treasury law enforcement school; and

**WHEREAS,** Wayne received numerous commendations from the U.S. Attorney's Office and outstanding performance awards from the Treasury Department. He is currently working on defense investigations and expert witness work as appointed by federal judges; and

WHEREAS, Wayne is the Sergeant-at-Arms of the Italian American Executives of Transportation and a recipient of the 2016 IAET President's Award and 2017 IAET Humanitarian of the Year. He has been chairman of their 2016-2018 golf outings. He serves as Treasurer for Knights of Columbus and the Italian American Police Association and is a member of the Chicagoland Italian American Charitable Organization; and
