

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CHICAGO:

Section 1. Pursuant to an ordinance heretofore passed by the City Council which allows erection of honorary street-name signs, the Commissioner of Transportation shall take the necessary action for standardization of 133rd Street and Houston Avenue as "Kenneth J. Miotk Way."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.
