WHEREAS, Philip Wherry won praise for his successful efforts to limit high-rise development and preserve brownstones on the Gold Coast by championing a revision of the City's zoning code; and

WHEREAS, His love of life and ability to live it to the fullest endeared Philip Wherry to his family members, friends and all who knew him, and enabled him to enrich their lives in ways they will never forget; and
