**SUBSTITUTE**  
**ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the designation and appropriate symbols and indications of a segment of the CERMAK ROAD right-of-way on Map No. 4-F and Map No. 6-F in the area bounded by:

South Princeton Avenue; South Wentworth Avenue

to designate such segment as a Pedestrian Street.


**SECTION 2.** Section 17-3-0503-D(1) of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and inserting the underscored language as follows:

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
