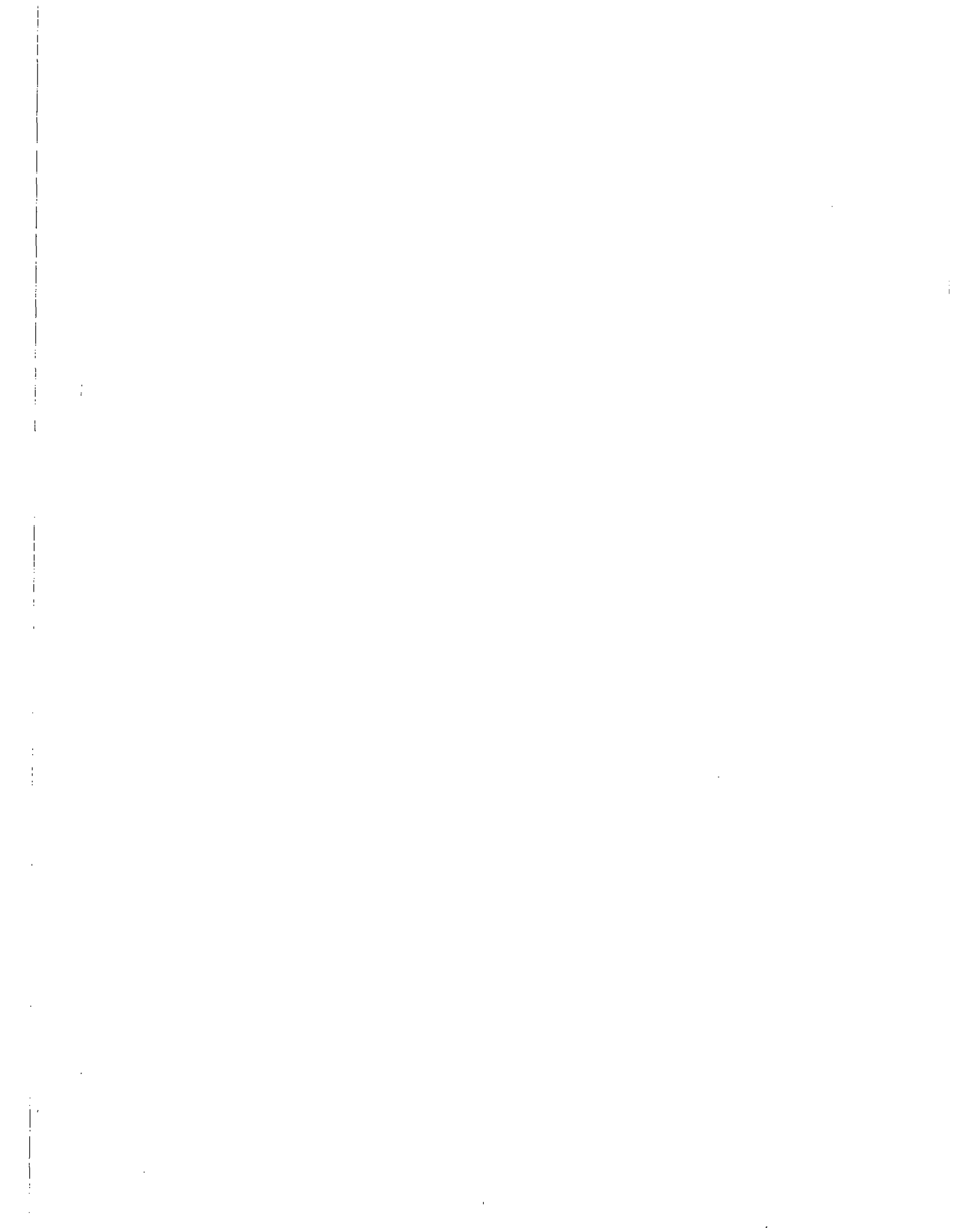

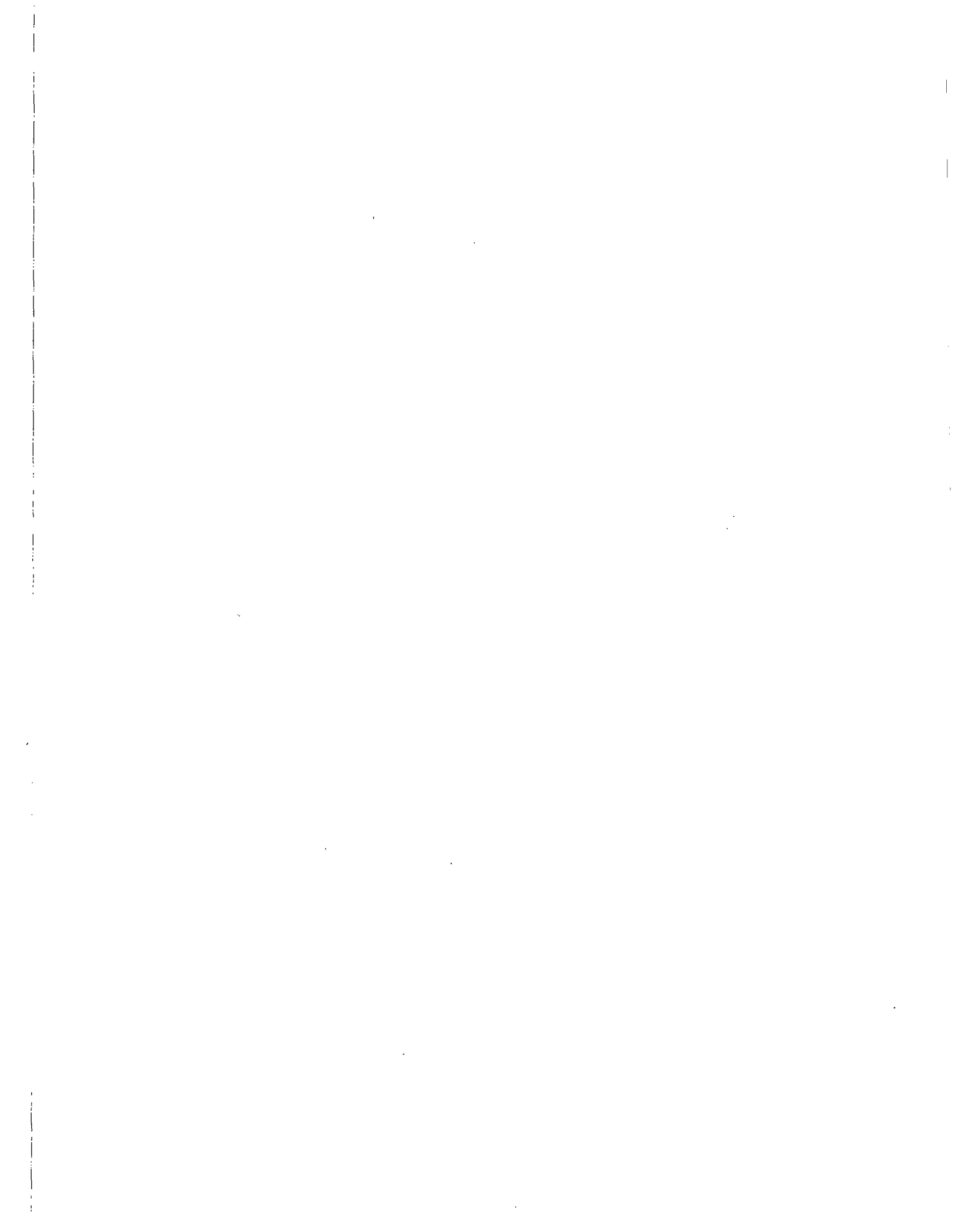
Ladies and Gentlemen:


