WHEREAS, A graduate of Yale University, the Honorable Malcolm Wallop worked as a rancher and meatpacking executive before entering public life; and

WHEREAS, Prior to being elected to the Senate, the Honorable Malcolm Wallop served two terms in the Wyoming House and one term in the Wyoming State Senate; and


WHEREAS, The Honorable Malcolm Wallop inspired the lives of countless people through his great personal goodness, charity and concern; and
