BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the B2-1 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 14-E in the area bounded by

A line 117.80 feet north of East 61st Street; the public alley next east of South Prairie Avenue; East 61st Street; South Prairie Avenue,

to those of an RM5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

In accordance with the requirements for an Amendment to the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, specifically Section 17-13-0107, please be informed that on or about September 3, 2012, the undersigned will file an application for a change in zoning from B2-1 Neighborhood Mixed Use District to RM5 Multi-Use District on behalf of St. Edmunds Redevelopment Corporation, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, for the property located at 300-314 E. 61st Street; 6049-6059 S. Prairie Avenue Street, Chicago, Illinois and described as follows:

a line 117.80 feet north of East 61st Street, the public alley next east of South Prairie Avenue, East 61st Street, South Prairie Avenue.

The purpose of the zoning amendment is to permit the applicant to develop a 12 dwelling unit building with 10 parking spaces. The building will have a building height of approximately 37 feet.
