*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to OLD ST MARYS, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 1500 S. Michigan Ave..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along S Michigan Ave:

One (1) at eight point zero eight (8.08) feet in length, five point one seven (5.17) feet in height and nine (9) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1132863 herein granted the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) per annum in advance.

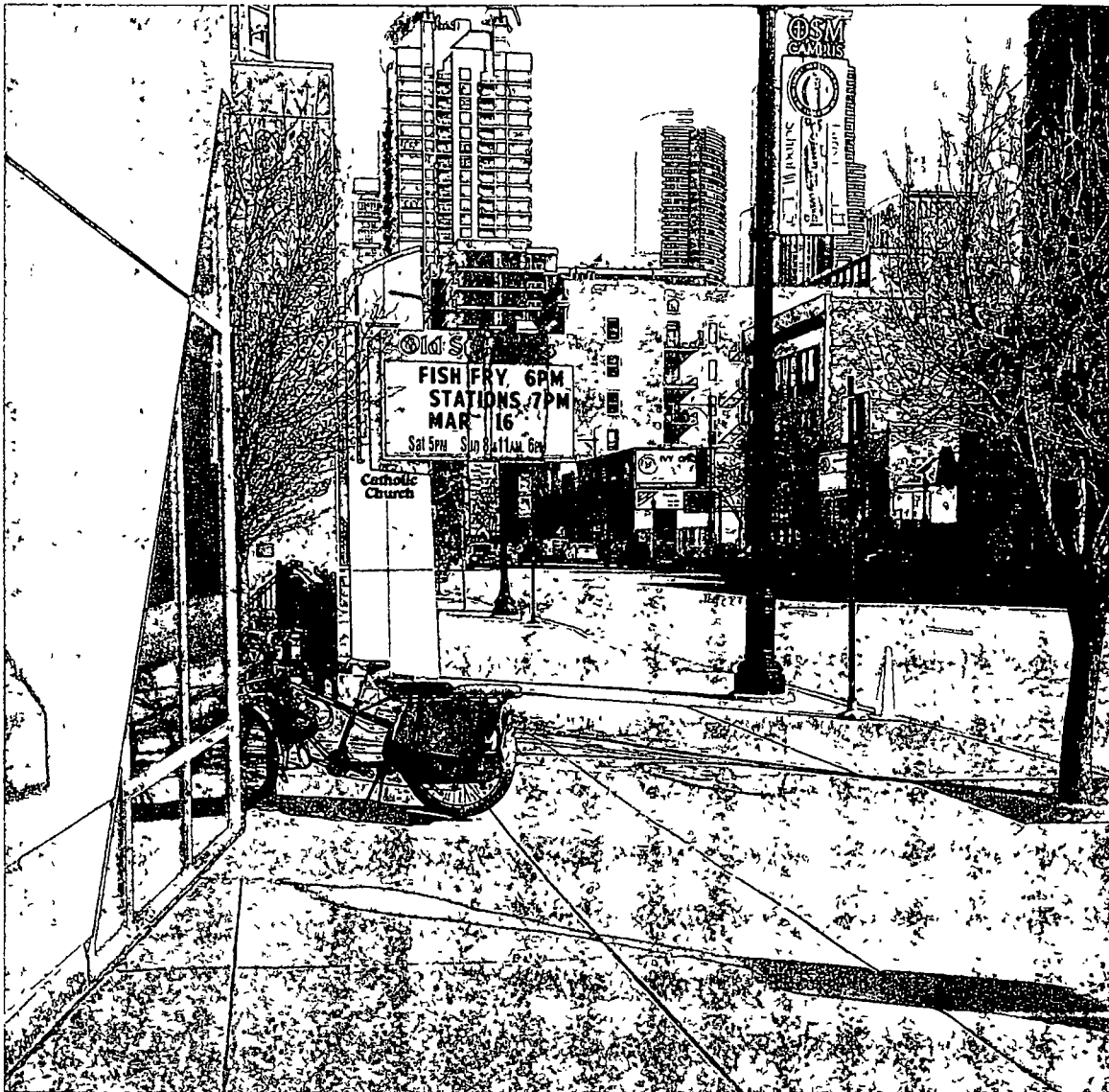
A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SYDNEE'S PET GROOMING, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Fence(s) on the public right-of-way for beautification purposes adjacent to its premises known as 1526 S. Wabash Ave..

Said Fence(s) at S. Wabash Avenue measure(s).

One (1) at six (6) feet in length, and six (6) feet in width for a total of thirty-six (36) square feet Said fence shall be approximately two (2) feet in height.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

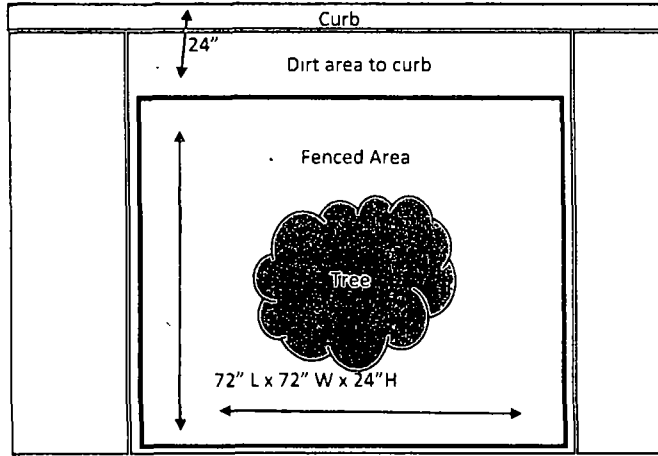
